


## Banasura Sagar Dam



# Thrissilery Shiva Temple

The idols and temple carvings are a feat of artistry and are magnificent sights. You can also glimpse at the temple tank that never dries up. The temple is open for all visitors regardless of religious affiliation. The annual festival during the months of March - April will witness the temple decked in all its glory.




# Thirunelli Temple

Distance from Resort: 49 km

The Thirunelli temple is famous for its connection to the story of Lord Rama. During Sri Rama's exile, Sri Rama, Lakshmana and Sita Devi are said to have lived in the Wayanad region. It is believed that Lord Rama, who heard the news of the death of his father, King Dasharatha during his exile, performed pitru tarpanam (final rites) at Tirunelli Sri Maha Vishnu Temple. The first part of the pujas involved in pitru tharpanam is performed at Trishileri and the subsequent ones at Tirunelli.



## Seetha Lava Kusha Temple

The only known Temple dedicated to Lava and Kusha, the sons of Lord Ram and Sita Devi. It is believed that Sita stayed at this temple during her exile and her sons grew up here. Sita Devi is the primary deity and her idol is known as 'Jadayatha Amma'. Many devotees consider this place sacred because of its connection to the story of Lava and Kusha. This was also the favored shrine of Pazhassi Raja.



# Puliyar Mala Jain Temple

Also known as the Anantnath Swami Temple, it is one of the oldest temples in Kerala built in the 13th century. It is a testament to the mastery and majesty of Jain architecture. Influence of the Dravidian style painting can also be seen all over the temple. It also has the largest brass idol and a carved statue of Lord Mahavir at the front door.



# Varambatta Mosque

Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary is divided into two sections: North Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary and South Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary. Muthanga falls under the southern section. The sanctuary is divided into four ranges based on the mountain ranges: Tholpetty, Kurichiat, Sulthan Bathery, and Muthanga.




